How are Scrutiny Reviews carried out?

Scrutiny Reviews are selected from issues which the Overview and Scrutiny Committee considers important to the people of Northampton. Scrutiny Panels are led by non-Executive Councillors.

Often, individuals and representatives of organisations, who have expertise or have expressed an interest in a particular subject, are co-opted to a Scrutiny Panel for the life of the Review. For the Scrutiny reviews this year, the Scrutiny Panels chose not to appoint co-optees, however, each Panel has an extensive expert advisor list (individuals who provide information to inform the evidence base of the Scrutiny review).

Scrutiny Panels are responsible for managing each review by gathering and taking evidence. At the end of the Review they present their findings to the Overview and Scrutiny Committee for approval. The report is then presented to Cabinet for its consideration and feedback.











Recently completed Reviews

Overview and Scrutiny completed three comprehensive reviews in 2014/2015:

- Interpersonal Violence (centring on domestic abuse)
- Poverty in the Town
- Keep Northampton Tidy

The O&S Committee also set up two Working Groups that undertook short, sharp reviews:

- Parking, with a particular focus on match day parking
- Tree Maintenance Issues

Current Reviews

The Overview and Scrutiny work Programme for 2015/2016 was recently approved. At its inaugural meeting on 6 July 2015, the Overview and Scrutiny Committee set up three in-depth Scrutiny Reviews. Scrutiny Panels will undertake these Reviews, reporting back to the Overview and Scrutiny Committee:

- Impact of Anti Social Behaviour on the Town
- Health Check of the Local Economy
- Effectiveness of the Enforcement of Licensing Policy in respect of Taxis and Private Hire

The Overview and Scrutiny Committee, at its meeting on 29 July 2015, approved the scopes (Terms of Reference) for these comprehensive reviews.

Review work of 2013/2014 has received Cabinet's response. Almost all of the recommendations were accepted, which highlights that Overview and Scrutiny is continuing to make significant influence of Council policy, both in terms of holding the Cabinet to account and contributing to policy development, and the well-being of the citizens of Northampton.
