How are Scrutiny Reviews carried out?

Scrutiny Panel Reviews are selected from issues which the Overview and Scrutiny Committee considers important to the people of Northampton.

Scrutiny Panels are led by Councillors. Often individuals and representatives of organisations, who have expertise or have expressed an interest in a particular subject, are co-opted to the Scrutiny Panel for the life of the Review.

Scrutiny Panels are responsible for managing each Review by gathering and taking evidence. At the end of the Review they present their findings to the Overview and Scrutiny Committee for approval.

Our Task and Finish Groups have now become Scrutiny Panels but please be assured that this is not just a name change. The main difference is that the Scrutiny Panels will be holding their meetings in public. Public addresses and public attendance is very much welcomed at these meetings, as it is for the Overview and Scrutiny Committee.

Scrutiny Activity for 2010/2011

The Overview and Scrutiny work programme for 2010/2010 was recently approved and the three in-depth Reviews that are currently underway are: -

- Northamptonshire Alcohol Strategy to review the local delivery of Northamptonshire Alcohol Strategy in Northampton
- Commissioning Framework for the Third Sector

 to investigate the development of a commissioning
 Framework for the Third Sector
- Absence Management to evaluate the impact that staff absence has upon service delivery.

What happened in Overview and Scrutiny over the last few months

The Overview and Scrutiny Annual Report 2009/2010 has recently been published and details the good work undertaken by the Scrutiny Committees and its Task and Finish Groups last year.

A short snapshot of the good work during 2009/2010: -

- Praise for Overview and Scrutiny A series of Overview and Scrutiny processes, procedures and documents have been commended.
- Dedicated four year rolling training programme for non-Executive Councillors
- Training session on Overview and Scrutiny for Officers
- Production of an Overview and Scrutiny Improvement Plan

Completed Reviews included:-

- More Facilities for Older Children The Review demonstrated good joint working with local partners and was undertaken as a result of the public's expressing the opinion that this subject matter should be scrutinised
- Concessionary Fares Appreciative Inquiry The Review was undertaken as a result of non-Executive's taking into consideration the public's concerns and comments around this issue.
- Community Centres This Review demonstrated Overview and Scrutiny, as a critical friend to Cabinet, supporting the development of Policy for Community Centres.
- Sheltered Housing and Housing Options for Older People - This was a comprehensive Review, which received a huge evidence base. The final report was presented to Cabinet in June 2010.
- Cost of Consultants Another comprehensive Review that reported its findings to Cabinet in June 2010.
