Notice of Interim Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places 2016

In accordance with **Section 18C** of the **Representation of the People Act 1983**, Northampton Borough Council gives notice that it is conducting an interim review of certain polling districts and polling places for Parliamentary and Local Government elections.

The Council welcomes views or comments from electors and any persons or bodies with expertise in access to premises or facilities for persons with any type of disability. Representations will also be sought from the Acting Returning Officers for the Parliamentary constituencies. Local political parties, District and County Councillors and Parish Councils will also be consulted.

The Acting Returning Officer's proposals for the new polling districts and suitability of polling stations will be published on Friday **18th November 2016** and will be available for inspection at the Council Offices and on the Council's website www.northampton.gov.uk

Any representations must be submitted in writing to the address below or by email to elecrag@northampton.gov.uk by not later than **Friday 9th December 2016**.

Details of all representations received will be made available for inspection.

The Council will consider the review proposals at its meeting to be held on Monday 23rd January and the outcome of the review will then be published. The proposals will be incorporated in the revised register to be published on 1st February 2017.
